2022 FEE CHANGE

Our manager indicated Ely Golf Club reached the maximum number of rounds playable on our course in 2021. Based on research, Ely seems to be as busy as other global golf courses. The National Golf Foundation, in January of 2022, reported 20 to 25 million more rounds of golf were played globally in 2021 than in 2020. The added boom for golf courses including Ely was fantastic. Unfortunately, the shortage of workers & recent skyrocketing prices of fuel, clubhouse goods & needed course products such as fertilizers, pesticides, & mechanical parts have offset revenue booms throughout the industry.

Green Fees & Cart Fees Increase \$2

With inflation being what it is, the Board & Finance Committee reviewed the rising costs of operating Ely Golf Club & looked at several budgeting, planning & savings alternatives. Ultimately the Board approved an increase in cart & green fees to help balance anticipated expenses. Hopefully the increased revenue will prevent dipping into savings. The board will closely monitor expenses required to maintain the course in top playing condition to minimize any future cost pressures.
