The program focuses on teaching and reinforcing golf skills and etiquette to students of all skill levels. In a fun and encouraging manner students learn, practice skills and play the game of golf on the course. Balls, tees, clubs and bag are provided. Volunteer coaches are seasoned players at Ely Golf Club. Five dollar per person discount for more than 2 household members-also free scholarships available.

On the first day, **students who need clubs** should arrive at 8:30. Camp begins at 9 a.m. Clearly **mark shafts** with identification when bringing own clubs. Lessons are outside all week. Players must be prepared with appropriate outdoor clothing, tennis or golf shoes (no flip flops, or crocs), jackets, and sun or bug repellant – See lotion permission on form below.

Students are divided by skill, age, and what works best for teaching success. Sometimes groups are gender specific. The club staff will assist with group level placement-see website descriptions. **Enrollment is limited** by group size. Priority is given to past participants and registration date. An **email** will be sent a few days before camp with final details. Students may request to be paired with one other student. Placement is determined by what is best for each particular coach and group level. On the **back lower half of this page** inform director Len Clewett of pairing requests and important **health**, **allergy**, **physical**, **social or emotional challenges**.
