Changes to club rates and fees made in 2023 along with great course conditions resulted in increased A SPECIAL THANK YOU TO SUPPORTERS OF THE 2ND ANNUAL 50/50 RAFFLE

club revenue from green fees and cart rentals. This revenue was needed to cover higher staff costs. In 2024 the finance committee and board agreed to no change in membership rates. The board changed the non-member cart lease fee to \$15/\$20 per seat for 9/18 holes due to another year of rate hikes by our lessor. The long-term success of our club requires yearly revenue to cover operating costs, essential equipment, and clubhouse repairs. Due to continued strong financial performance in 2023, the club was able to achieve that obligation and purchase in full a quality replacement fairway mower. We also replaced the aging deck and cleared several trees to provide a pleasing view of the ninth fairway.

We are blessed with tremendous support from members who help maintain the appearance of the course. Thanks to the many individuals who donate and volunteer their time and or equipment clearing brush, trees, completing large landscape projects, maintaining the flower beds, supporting youth golf camp and helping with other big and small tasks. This year we plan to host Ely youth golf camp on June 11-14. Thirty-five Ely youth participated last year, including twenty first timers. project is now complete. It is so much better to have the newer or rebuilt

machines like the sweeper, fairway and rough mower. Thank you. My staff and I are looking forward to the challenge of getting the course in top shape for the 2024 season. Below are a few hints on how to "leave the course better than you found it".

ALL 4 TIRES ON CART PATH — We don't have the luxury of widening the paths to make passing lanes but you can protect the surfaces by staying in your lane. ☑ It is natural to want to pullover to talk but wheels ½ on ½ off the path can create bare spots, holes, ruts and can break the asphalt. This is costly and timely to repair. If you need to go around a cart do so in the rough or on the fairway.

FILLING TEE BOX DIVOTS — If a divot is intact with soil and roots - replace it. Smooth it out by tapping (not stomping) with your foot. If the turf explodes or is bare, add the soil mix until level with base of surrounding grassgently tap and smooth out.

BUNKER RAKES — In Ely it is preferred rakes be placed tines down in the bunkers. Don't placed them cross line of play, on a slope or near the lip. This creates bad lies or potential penalties for others. This is not a USGA rule — courses may choose their preference.




